IGN Live Attendee Event Policies

Age Restriction

IGN Live is accessible to people of all ages.

Code of Conduct

We want to cultivate a fun and safe environment for all those attending IGN Live. As such, we ask all attendees to respect each other and follow common-sense rules for public behavior, personal interaction, common courtesy, and respect for personal property. Any harassment, offensive or bullying behavior will not be tolerated. IGN reserves the right to revoke, without refund, the ticket of any attendee who violates this policy among any other recourse it deems necessary in its sole discretion. If any attendee finds themselves in a situation where they feel unsafe or they become aware of another attendee violating this policy, they should immediately locate the nearest security member or IGN staff member so that the matter can be handled immediately.

Appearance Release

Attendees will be filmed and photographed in connection with the event. By attending the event, attendees grant IGN permission to tape, photograph and record them in connection with their appearance and attendance at the event. IGN will be the exclusive owner of the results of any and all taping, photography and recording with the perpetual worldwide right to use and to license others to use said results in any way, in all markets and media (whether now known or hereafter developed), in connection with the event and/or other productions, products or services of IGN or IGN's clients, including for licensing and promotion thereof.

At the event, attendees agree not to create, transmit, display, distribute, exploit, misappropriate or sell for any commercial or non-personal purpose (1) any description or account (in any form, whether text, data or visual, and including, without limitation, play-by-play data) of the event; or (2) any images, videos, audio or other form of display or public performance or reproduction of any portion of the event ("Works"). Additionally, attendees are not permitted to livestream any portion of the event ("Livestreams") unless explicitly granted permission by IGN. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if an attendee attends the event and disregards this policy, attendee, by default, grants IGN an exclusive worldwide, irrevocable, perpetual, sub-licensable, royalty-free license to all rights associated with any Works and Livestreams.

Prohibited Items

No Weapons Are Allowed

No weapons of any kind are permitted at IGN Live. A non-exhaustive list of what is not permitted is as follows: All Metal Weapons, Firearms including relic antique firearms, Ammunition, Rifles,

Shotguns, Handguns, Blowguns, Tasers, Laser Pointers, Laser-Aiming Devices or similar Laser Devices, Explosives, Incendiary Devices, Chemical Weapons, and Pepper Spray / Mace, Knives, Live Blades/Swords (including Katana and other Martial Arts Style Swords), Daggers, Sword Canes, Switchblades, Bali-Song (Butterfly Knife), Axes, Kunai, Ice Skates, Hatchets, Metal Pole Arms, Wooden/Metal Bats, Paddles, Stilts, Golf Clubs, Vuvuzelas, Archery and Hunting Bows, Arrows, Nunchucks, Brass Knuckles, Whips, and Curios.

Any item designed or manufactured with the intent to cause death or serious bodily injury to any person or property whether carried openly or concealed even if such weapons are inoperable or unusable are not permitted. Additionally, you are not permitted to bring any item that is illegal in the state of California, or any item that appears, in IGN's sole discretion, to be dangerous or which would pose or place others at risk or harm, immediate or otherwise. If an attendee brings a weapon or what IGN determines in its sole discretion to be a weapon to the event, IGN may confiscate the item and eject the attendee from the premises for the remainder of the event.

Dress Code

We celebrate the creativity of our audience and encourage attendees to cosplay whomever they wish–regardless of size, gender, age, religion, shape, color, or even species. Have fun with it!

We ask that you follow the guidelines below and please keep in mind that IGN Live is an all-ages event.

- Shoes are required at all times. Cosplaying a character that's barefoot? Please check out online tutorials on how to make "invisible shoes."
- Costumes and clothing should not expose the body in such a way as to be deemed indecent exposure in Los Angeles, California. Private parts must be covered in an opaque material that will not slip or have gaps.
- Males wearing tight-fitting costumes are required to wear a dance belt.
- Costumes must not obstruct or impede the flow of traffic or entryways. If the costume cannot fit through a standard doorway, it may not be allowed at the event.
- Attendees with bulky costumes, costumes that obscure the vision, or costumes with large extensions such as wings or spikes, should have a designated "handler," to assist them through the hallways and crowds.
- Functioning wheels cannot be used as part of a costume or prop (i.e. anything that you might ride, push, or pull).
- No costumes may be realistic depictions of American law enforcement, current American
 military uniforms, first responders, emergency medical personnel, or any official government
 agent. "Vintage," historical, any non-current uniforms, and any military or police-style
 costumes may be addressed at IGN's discretion (i.e., Resident Evil, Metal Gear Solid, etc.)

• Hate symbols of any kind are not permitted. It is within IGN's sole discretion whether an attendee's clothing or prop contains a hate symbol.

No Large Personal Items

Please be aware that, for safety reasons, no handcarts, trolleys, rolling luggage, or oversized strollers are allowed in the event. Attendees found on the exhibit floor with these items will be removed from the event.

No Segways or Hoverboards

Segways, scooters, bicycles and hoverboards are not allowed at IGN Live, including the various exhibit halls, programming rooms, and outside areas of Magic Box.

No Selfie Sticks or Similar Devices

Selfie sticks, GoPro poles, stilts, or any device that extends your camera or phone away from your hand or body are not allowed at IGN Live. If you're seen with one of these devices, you will be asked by security to put it away and not use it at IGN Live. This includes all of Magic Box's exhibit halls, programming and event rooms, etc.

No Smoking

Smoking is not allowed at any time at IGN Live. No smoking includes vaping and e-cigarettes. This policy extends to all parts of the event including the designated outdoor area for the event. Noncompliance with this policy may result in ejection from the event.

COVID-19

We are actively monitoring health developments regarding the COVID-19 virus and will follow the safety guidelines from the CDC as well as any applicable federal, state and local laws. We cannot guarantee attendees will not become infected with COVID-19 or other illnesses. Thus, we encourage all attendees to make informed decisions regarding their own personal health as well as the health of others.

Attendees should not attend the event if:

- They are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, as identified at CDC.gov;
- They have tested positive COVID-19; or
- They have been exposed to someone who is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or has tested positive for COVID-19.
